Hello,

It looks like there may be a small discrepancy between the rule and the instructions on the Proof of Claim (B10) form (currently and as proposed to be amended). Rule 3001(c)(1) states, in part, "...when a claim, or an interest in property of the debtor securing the claim, is based in writing, the original or duplicate shall be filed with the proof of claim..."

Paragraph 7 of the Proof of Claim filing instructions states "...Do not send original documents, as attachments may be destroyed after scanning." Everywhere else in the B10 instructions the instructions say to attach copies.

Perhaps simply removing the words "original or" from the rule would solve this?
